## Social & Academic Probation Agreement for 4-12 Grade Students

In accordance with MVCS policy and procedure, every new student will automatically be placed on a social and academic probation status for the first academic quarter the student is enrolled at the school. The school administration does enforce this policy and monitors the progress of each student during this probation period.

At the end of the probation period, the parents/guardians will receive a note or a phone call indicating their child's probation status:

1. If the student is progressing well, the probation status will be lifted.
2. If minor concerns still exist, the administration may ask that the student remain on probation for an additional grading period, to be followed by another evaluation of the student's progress.
3. If substantial progress is not being made and problems continue to exist, the administration in consultation with the parents may decide that MVCS cannot meet the academic/social needs of their son/daughter. If this is the case, the student will be withdrawn from the school.
